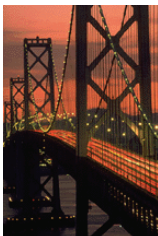

TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION CULMINATING ASSESSMENT

The technology education online culminating assessment has been designed to provide technology teachers and other technology professionals with an efficient and effective tool to gauge student comprehension and academic perform-



ance related to technological literacy. The assessment covers a broad range of technological content and has been validated as an accurate measure of performance. The assessment is designed to be used with middle school or high school students as they complete their total

program of studies in either the eighth or twelfth grade. The assessment can be used at other times by teachers desiring to measure student achievement. The instrument is designed so that instructors can complete pre-test and post-test assessment with students in their classes.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

The following steps outline procedures for using the online assessment:

1. The assessment Web site is located at <http://www.uga.edu/teched/assess>
2. Instructors using the assessment for the first time should click the instructor materials link and sign up for an account on the online system. An instructor ID will be generated and this number will be used by students completing the assessment. **Do not share your instructor password with students or anyone else.**
3. Students will need to be provided with a username, password, and the instructor ID number to enter the assessment area.

High School username & password: hste / ch2005
Middle School username & password: mste / rb2005

4. Once a student completes the appropriate assessment and responses are submitted, a screen will notify them of their results.
5. Instructors can re-enter the instructor materials area to retrieve scores for their students.
6. Scores are reported based on the instructor ID#. If a teacher desires to administer the assessment to the same students more than once, an additional ID# should be obtained and used.

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
