This is an appeal by Derek M. (“Appellant”) from an April 12, 1990, decision by the Decatur County Board of Education (“Local Board”) to expel Appellant for the remainder of the semester because he was involved in transporting property that was stolen from the Bainbridge High School Coliseum. Appellant maintains that he was denied due process and the evidence did not support the Local Board’s decision.

The suspension period has passed and Appellant is eligible to attend summer school. The State Board of Education cannot provide Appellant with any relief. The appeal is moot and is, therefore, hereby dismissed.
