This is an appeal by Colin P. (Student) from a decision by the Charlton County Board of Education (Local Board) not to take any action concerning the decision to bar him from participating in golf and baseball during the spring quarter of the 1993-1994 school year because he had been charged with vandalizing private property. The Student's appeal is moot because the suspension period has passed and the State Board of Education cannot provide any relief. Additionally, the Local Board did not sit as a tribunal and make a decision concerning the interpretation or administration of school law. The State Board of Education, therefore, does not have jurisdiction to consider the Student's appeal. Accordingly, the appeal is

DISMISSED.
