This is an appeal by the parents of C. B. W. (Student) from a March 29, 1994, decision by the Fulton County Board of Education (Local Board) to uphold the decision of a Student Disciplinary Tribunal to transfer the Student to another middle school after finding that the Student violated the Local Board's policy against weapons in school because he admittedly brought a switchblade knife to school. The Student's parents claim that the disciplinary measure was too harsh. The transfer period has passed and the appeal is moot because the State Board of Education is unable to provide any relief to the Student. The appeal, therefore, is DISMISSED.
