DECISION

This is an appeal by Carnell Florence (Appellant) from a decision by the McIntosh County Board of Education (Local Board) to terminate his contract based upon charges of insubordination, willful neglect of duties, and other good and sufficient causes. Appellant, a special education teacher, was charged with kicking one of his students, sleeping in class after being directed not to sleep in class, and being disrespectful to parents. Appellant claims there was no credible evidence to support the Local Board's decision, and the Local Board improperly denied him a continuance of the hearing. Appellant failed to file a brief with the State Board of Education or request oral arguments and has not cited any error of law. Because Appellant failed to pursue his appeal, the appeal is hereby dismissed.
