This is an appeal by Tonya W. (Student) from a November 1, 1994, decision by the Liberty County Board of Education to uphold the decision of the Student Disciplinary Tribunal to suspend her for the remainder of the 1994-1995 school year after finding her guilty of possessing marijuana seeds on school property with intent to distribute them. The Student failed to perfect her appeal to the State Board of Education because a brief was not filed and oral argument was not requested. Because of the failure to perfect the appeal, the appeal is dismissed.
