This is an appeal by C. T. (Student) from a decision by the Muscogee County Board of Education to uphold the decision of a student disciplinary tribunal to assign him to an alternative school for 90 days after finding him guilty of possessing drugs. The Student failed to file a brief or request oral argument. The Student's appeal, therefore, is deemed to have been abandoned. *Chris M. v. McIntosh Cnty. Bd. of Educ.*, Case No. 1995-47 (Ga. SBE, Jan. 11, 1996). Additionally, the expulsion period has passed and the State Board of Education cannot provide the Student with any relief, thus making the issues raised moot. Accordingly, the appeal is hereby  
**DISMISSED.**
