Course Title: Accounting

Project Name: Career Project—Climbing the Career Ladder

Time: 5 hours

Objectives: The student will be able to identify how accounting serves as a

basis for careers.

Materials Needed: project board, construction paper, glue, scissors, and markers

Resources Needed: textbook, newspapers, Internet or other media resources

Student Handouts: Climbing the Accounting Career Ladder

Interdisciplinary Involvement: Language Arts

Step-by-Step Instructions:

- 1. Divide students into four groups to do career research. Each group will be responsible for a different rung on the career ladder. (General Office Clerks, Accounting Clerks, Bookkeepers, and Accountants)
- 2. Each student will then look in the local newspaper's classified ads and find a job that relates to the rung that they were assigned.
- 3. Once they find a job that they are interested in the student will cut the ad out.
- 4. The student will then research the job to find out pertinent information such as work activities, aptitudes, physical demands, work settings, wages, employment outlook, educational preparation and opportunities for advancement in the selected job.
- 5. Student will then use the data collected to create a project board to display the information in a creative manner.
