

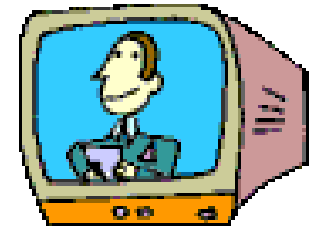

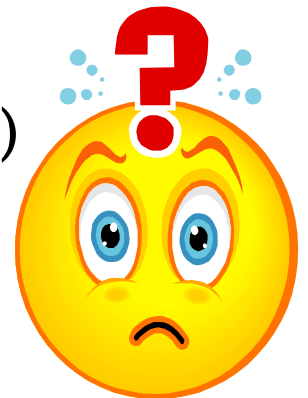

Did you know.....

- ▶ 76 percent of 8– to 18–year olds own an iPod or MP3 player.
- ▶ 66 percent own cell phones and 29 percent own laptops (Kaiser Family Foundation, 2010).
- ▶ Among 12– to 17–year–olds, 75 percent own cell phones.

Did you know.....

62 percent of students prefer mobile devices over laptops or netbooks, and they say they would use mobile devices to better communicate, look up information on the Internet, and be more productive with their schoolwork (Project Tomorrow, 2010).

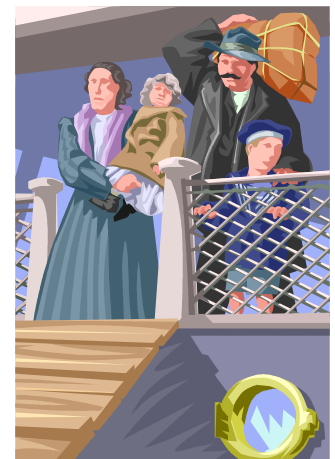


What does that mean?

Uniquely Equipped for Students with Disabilities

Accessibility options:

▶ VoiceOver

- gesture-based screen reader
- touch the screen to hear a description of the item under your finger
- then double-tap to select and item
- flick with three fingers to move to another home screen or turn a page in a book
- VoiceOver speaks over 30 languages



Uniquely Equipped for Students with Disabilities

Accessibility options:

▶ Enhanced rotor

- VoiceOver also features a virtual control called the rotor
- Turning the rotor by rotating two fingers on the screen as if you were turning a dial



Uniquely Equipped for Students with Disabilities

Accessibility options:

▶ Mono audio

- route both right- and left-channel audio into both headphones, so you can hear both channels in either ear to support



Uniquely Equipped for Students with Disabilities

Accessibility options:

- ▶ Support for wireless Braille displays
- ▶ iPad supports more than 30 Bluetooth wireless Braille displays
- ▶ start using it to navigate your iPad with VoiceOver



Uniquely Equipped for Students with Disabilities

Accessibility options:

- ▶ **Zoom** allows you to magnify the entire screen of any application up to five times the normal size
- ▶ **Zoom** works everywhere
- ▶ The **Large Font** feature in iPad lets you increase the font size of key elements in Mail, Contacts, Notes and Messages



Uniquely Equipped for Students with Disabilities

Accessibility options:

- ▶ **Closed Captioning**
Every iPad can display subtitles and closed captioning for the deaf and hard of hearing when playing movies, streaming live HTTP video or viewing podcasts that support it.



Uniquely Equipped for Students with Disabilities

Accessibility options:

- ▶ **White on black.**
 - iPad lets you change the display to white on black for higher contrast.
 - Use the White on Black feature in any application, including the Home, Unlock and Spotlight screens



Uniquely Equipped for Students with Disabilities

Accessibility options:

- ▶ **Triple-click Home**
 - If you only use the VoiceOver, White on Black or Zoom features occasionally enable the Triple-click Home feature
 - Set Triple-click Home to “ask” and it will display a list of your options so you can choose the right one when you need it.

License Terms

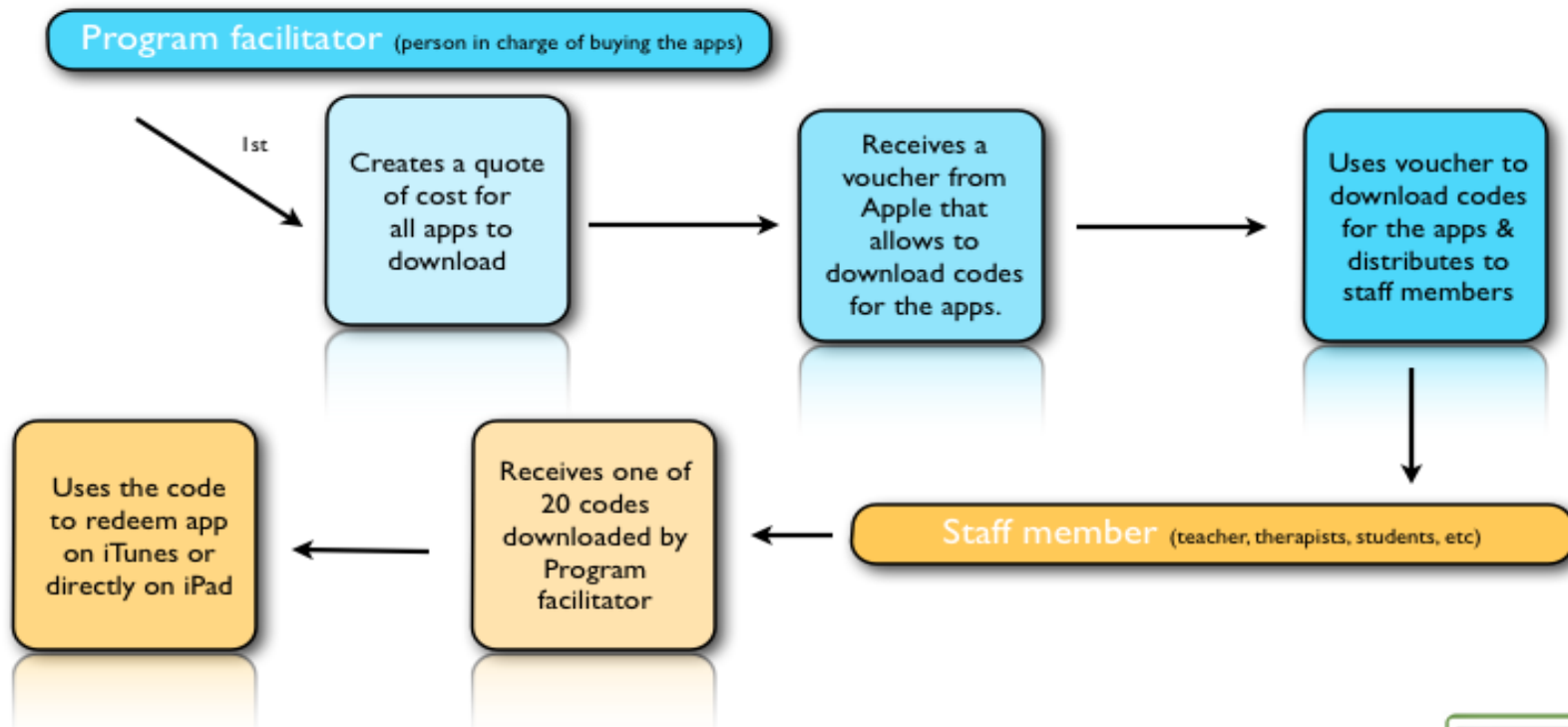


- ▶ If You are a commercial enterprise or educational institution, You may download and sync a Product for use by either :
 - (a) a single individual on one or more devices you own or control or
 - (b) multiple individuals, on a single shared device you own or control.

If the device and software is owned by and educational institution it is either one license per device used by multiple students, or one license per student using multiple devices. This applies to both licenses purchased through VPP (Volume Purchase Program) and normal iTunes purchases.

Volume Purchase Program- 50% off Educational discount for iPad Apps

*when downloading 20 or more copies of the same application



*School districts can decide to give codes to staff to be downloaded on their personal iTunes account or they can create several iTunes accounts that belong to the school district.

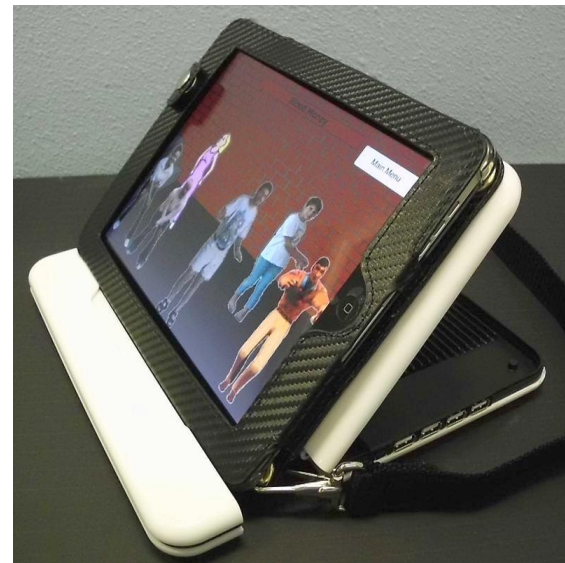

Tips and Tricks

▶ Screen Shots

To take **screen shots** of your various displays on your devices, press the “home” and “sleep” keys at the same time. The screen shot will be saved in your photos and can be emailed or used in presentations.



Tips and Tricks

- ▶ **Switch between apps**
 - Double-click the Home button to reveal your recently used apps
 - Scroll right to see more apps, then tap one to reopen it
 - App will open to where you left off allowing you to have multiple apps open at one time



Tips and Tricks

▶ Creating Folders

- Create folders to organize your apps
- Press and hold an app until it begins to wiggle
- Drag one application on top of another and name the folder
- You can have up to 12 apps in a folder



Tips and Tricks

- ▶ **Restrict Deleting Apps and Access to YouTube...**
 - Go to Settings
 - Select Restrictions
 - Set a password to enable restrictions
 - You can also deny access to YouTube, Safari and iTunes
 - If you choose to restrict these apps, they will not even appear on the device
 - You can also set Content ratings for Music, Movies, TV Shows, Apps, etc.

“App”solutely Amazing Apps

Things to consider:

- ▶ Wi-Fi without 3G allows network content filters to protect students from navigating to inappropriate websites.
- ▶ Have a separate generic iTunes account for each device to allow for ease in backing up purchased Applications.
- ▶ Obtaining apps through Volume Purchasing or Vouchers allows the use of purchase orders.
- ▶ Determine set guidelines for making requests for application purchases.
- ▶ Consider a core package of applications that comes standard with every iPad issued. (iWorks, iBooks, Calculator, Dragon Speak, dictionary)



“App”solutely Amazing Apps

More things to consider:

- ▶ Consider what accessories will be needed (speakers, cases, etc)
- ▶ Purchase Apple Care plan
- ▶ Consider Printing needs
- ▶ Set up Wiki or information board to share information between teachers
