#### **Access to the Curriculum**





#### IDEA



- Each public agency must ensure that—
- (i) To the maximum extent appropriate, children with disabilities, including children in public or private institutions or other care facilities, are educated with children who are nondisabled; and



#### IDEA Cont...



• (ii) Special classes, separate schooling, or other removal of children with disabilities from the regular educational environment occurs only if the nature or severity of the disability is such that education in regular classes with the use of Supplementary aids and services cannot be Achieved satisfactorily.

#### **IDEA Cont...**



• (a) Each public agency **must ensure** that a **continuum** of **alternative placements** is available to meet the needs of children with disabilities for special education and related services.

#### **IDEA CONT...**



- (b) The continuum <u>required</u> in paragraph (a) of this section <u>must</u>—
- (1) **Include** the alternative placements listed in the definition of special education under §300.38 (instruction in regular classes, special classes, special schools, home instruction, and instruction in hospitals and institutions);

#### **IDEA CONT...**

- In determining the educational placement of a child with a disability, <u>including a preschool child</u> with a disability, each public agency **must** ensure that—
- (a) The placement decision—
- (1) Is made by a group of persons, including the **parents**, and other persons knowledgeable about the child, the meaning of the evaluation data, and the placement options;

### OSEP REQUIREMENT



Percent of children aged 3 through 5 with IEPs attending a:

- A. Regular early childhood program and receiving the majority of special education and related services in the regular early childhood program; and
- B. Separate special education class, separate school or residential facility.

(20 U.S.C. 1416(a)(3)(A))

#### **OSEP REQUIREMENTS**

- 2010-2011 Data will be reported as baseline.
- Targets will be set for the next couple of years.
- Measurements & Public reporting expected to begin with the 2011-2012 data.
