PBIS District Commitment Form

Georgia Department of Education will provide:

- 1. Initial and follow-up PBIS Team training.
- 2. PBIS coaches' training.
- 3. Training on School-Wide Information System (SWIS).
- 4. On-going technical assistance to District Coordinator and PBIS coach(es).
- 5. Assistance with interpretation and strategic planning of data reports.

District will commit to:

- 1. Designating and supporting a District-wide PBIS coordinator and School-wide PBIS coach(es). Depending on the size and number of schools, one person may fulfill both roles.
- 2. Forming a district discipline leadership team to plan, analyze and review schools' discipline data.

School teams will commit to:

- 1. Attending PBIS training.
- 2. Using team based problem-solving process to provide interventions for all students.
- 3. Collecting monthly discipline data for decision-making purposes.
- 4. Meeting at least monthly to analyze and problem-solve school-wide discipline data.
- 5. Using and submitting required data on a regular basis.
- 6. Working with the District PBIS Coach to implement PBIS with fidelity.
- 7. Implementing PBIS for 3 years.

Principal will commit to:

- 1. Being an active team participant (attend trainings and team meetings).
- 2. Identifying and organizing a representative team to attend training for 2 days.
- 3. Providing opportunities for the PBIS team to meet as specified.
- 4. Budgeting funds for PBIS supplies, materials, reinforcers, travel and substitutes for training, etc.)
