DECISION

This is an appeal by B. M. (Student) from a decision by the Lumpkin County Board of Education to uphold the decision of a student disciplinary tribunal to suspend him from regular school for the remainder of the 2002-2003 school year and assign him to an alternative school program for 90 days beginning August 18, 2003 after finding him guilty of making written threats against school personnel. The Student failed to file a brief or request oral argument. The Student's appeal, therefore, is deemed to have been abandoned. *Chris M. v. McIntosh Cnty. Bd. of Educ.*, Case No. 1995-47 (Ga. SBE, Jan. 11, 1996). In addition, the period of suspension and alternative school has passed and the State Board of Education cannot provide the Student with any relief, which makes the appeal moot. Accordingly, the appeal is hereby DISMISSED.
