This is an appeal by P. W. (Student) from a decision by the Jones County Board of Education (Local Board) to uphold the decision of a student disciplinary tribunal to assign him to an alternative school for the remainder of the 2006-2007 school year and attend a drug awareness program after finding him guilty of possessing marijuana in school. The Student claims that there was no evidence to support the tribunal's decision. Since the school year is over, the State Board of Education cannot provide the Student with any relief. The issues raised, therefore, are moot. Accordingly, the appeal is hereby
DISMISSED.
