This is an appeal by J. G. (Student) from a decision by the Henry County Board of Education	
(Local Board) to uphold the decision of a student disciplinary tribunal to expel him from regular school	
until June 2, 2007, with the option of attending an alternative school during his expulsion term, after	
finding him guilty of disrupting school operations and verbally abusing others. The Student claims that	
the evidence did not support the charges and that the Local Board's decision violates the Individuals with	
Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. Secs. 1400 et seq. (the "Act" or "IDEA").* The Student's expulsion	
period has passed and the State Board of Education cannot provide him with any relief. The issues raised	
by the Student, therefore, are moot. Accordingly, the Student's appeal is hereby	
DISMISSED.
