This is an appeal by K. H. (Student) from a decision by the Douglas County Board of Education to uphold the decision of a student disciplinary tribunal to suspend her from regular school until the end of the 2008-2009 school year after finding her guilty of selling a drug "look-alike" (Kool-Aid<sup>®</sup> and sugar). The Student failed to file a timely brief or request oral argument. The Student's appeal, therefore, is deemed to have been abandoned. *Chris M. v. McIntosh Cnty. Bd. of Educ.*, Case No. 1995-47 (Ga. SBE, Jan. 11, 1996). Additionally, the suspension period has passed and the State Board of Education cannot provide the Student with any relief, thus making the issues raised moot.

Accordingly, the appeal is hereby  
DISMISSED.
